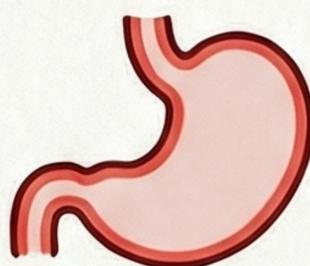

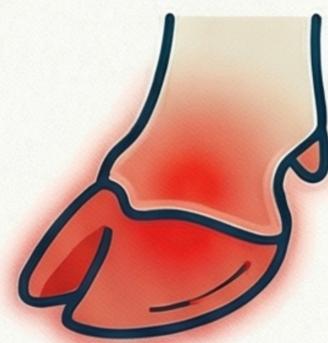
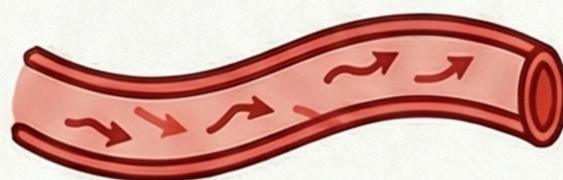
RUMEN ACIDOSIS TRIGGERS LAMINITIS

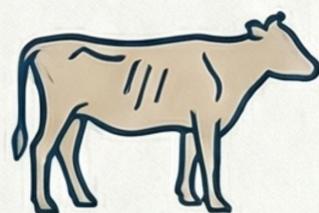

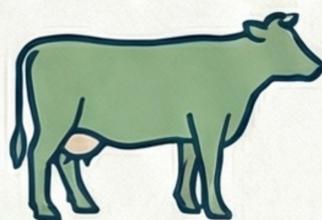

Low Body Condition Scores (BCS) are associated with a thinner digital cushion, increasing the risk of painful sole ulcers.



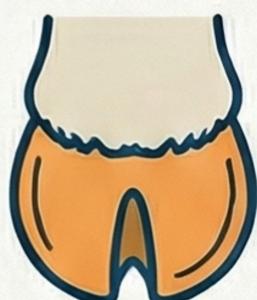
LOW BCS



OPTIMAL BCS



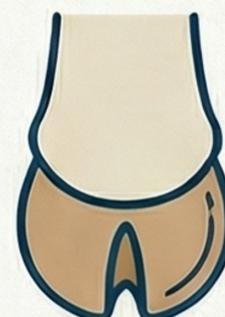
THIN CUSHION & ULCER RISK
